# ICC'2012 – Call for Participation

## **Background**

The goal of the 2012 International Create Challenge (ICC'2012) is to foster the creation of start-ups within the framework of Human & Media Computing. ICC'2012 is an initiative supported by the National Centre of Competence in Research (NCCR) on Interactive Multimodal Information Management (IM2, <a href="www.im2.ch">www.im2.ch</a>), via its association (AIM2), and the Idiap Research Institute (Idiap, <a href="www.idiap.ch">www.idiap.ch</a>).

ICC'2012 is a free of charge 3-week immersive technology transfer accelerator program giving entrepreneurs the unique opportunity to develop their original idea towards a "Minimum Viable Product" (e.g., demonstrator, product prototype) in collaboration with groups of entrepreneurs and researchers.

ICC'2012 combines the availability of state-of-the-art technologies, cutting edge research, mentor-led coaching, and micro-seed investment. The winning team(s) will share global award amounting to more than 200'000 CHF. ICC'2012 can accommodate up to 30 participants, ideally split into teams of 2 to 4 people.

## **Application**

By opening this call for participation, AIM2 and Idiap seek to attract highly motivated "entrepreneurs" to create or join a team, develop their original idea towards a "Minimum Viable Product", eventually resulting in the creation of a company.

Participants can apply as the representative of a group (to be briefly described) or as individuals interested in joining an initiative.

The call is split into two successive competitive steps:

#### Step 1: People

Applicants should submit their CV (max 2 pages, one sided) and a cover letter (max 1 page, one sided) explaining their motivation. An Evaluation Committee will select the participants/teams based on:

- Quality of CV and expertise in the field of "Human & Media Computing"
- Motivation to develop ideas, create/join a team, and share skills.

The successful applicants will have the opportunity to network/interact through the ICC'2012 Web Platform (<a href="www.createchallenge.org">www.createchallenge.org</a>). If necessary, they will also have access to the IM2 and Idiap Technology Portfolio if needed to exploit their initial idea.





#### Step 2: Projects

The successful applicants will have to setup a team of 2 to 4 people, which will submit a detailed work plan (max 5 pages, one sided) further discussing their project, with a clear description of the (business) opportunity, the challenge, and the development approach. Ideally, projects should exploit Information and Communication Technologies (ICT) as available within IM2 and Idiap.

#### **Application process**

Only complete applications successfully submitted online via the ICC'2012 platform will be considered (www.createchallenge.org/submission). Receipt of submission will be acknowledged by email.

#### **Selection process**

An independent Evaluation Committee of experts in the field of Human & Media Computing will be in charge of the selection procedures.

#### **Commitment and duration**

Successful teams commit themselves to participate in the ICC'2012, which will take place from 1 to 21 September 2012 at the Centre du Parc in Martigny, Switzerland (www.hotelduparc.ch). Selected participants will have their living expenses (housing and meals, except drinks) fully covered by ICC'2012.

At the end of ICC'2012, the best projects/prototypes/teams will be awarded between 20'000.- and 150'000.- CHF, depending on their decision (or not) to create their company locally by integrating the IdeArk Incubator (www.ideark.ch).

#### **Eligibility**

Applicants must be skilled developers, researchers, designers or entrepreneurs. Projects should exploit Information and Communication Technologies as available within IM2 and Idiap.

#### **Important Dates**

- Step 1 deadline: 30 May 2012 (11:59pm CET)
- Step 1 notification of decision: 8 June 2012
- Step 2 deadline: 15 July 2012 (11:59pm CET)
- Step 2 notification of decision: 30 July 2012
- Start of the ICC'2012: 1 September 2012 for a duration of 3 weeks (end 21 September).
- Closing ceremony, award announcement and press conference: 21 September
