


Startupticker.ch has compiled the first transparent **Swiss Venture Capital Report**, based on our continuous reporting of the financing rounds of Swiss start-ups over the past year as well as on information received by CTI Invest, CTI Start-up and/or the involved companies and investors.

Key findings


All in all, the numbers are impressive: in 2012 we found more than 65 companies, which generated more than CHF 400 million in venture capital. This compares very favourably with the figures from Germany in 2011, the Bundesverband Deutscher Kapitalbeteiligungsgesellschaften reported venture capital investments of €690 million and additional growth investments of €510 million.

Of the 67 companies, which published information about their financing rounds, 29 are from the ICT, 10 from biotech and 12 from medtech sector. ICT is represented very strongly, followed by the traditional Swiss Medtech sector. Micro/Nano start-ups accounted for 3 financing rounds, cleantech for 5 and interdisciplinary for 8.



For the analysis of the invested sum we used some confidential information plus estimates where necessary. The strength of ICT and medtech start-ups is also reflected in the invested sum. On the other hand, cleantech investments are very weak: the only big investment last year came from

BikeTec, producer of the Flyer e-bike. Apart from this, the other 4 cleantech start-ups generated no more than CHF 5.5 million.



If we look at the phases and investment amounts, the following situation can be observed:

The number of deals in Early Stage Investments almost equals the number of Later Stage Investments; however the volume of the latter is several times higher. This of course makes sense in the view of the capital need in the growth or expansion phase.

Nevertheless, the average Early Stage round is only CHF 1.3 Mio., showing that it is not so easy to collect enough money in this early phase to accelerate the market entry in a global market.

The low number of listed Seed rounds can be explained by the fact that these companies very often do not yet communicate or do not use our ticker.

Swiss start-ups attract a variety of investors and only a few are mentioned more than once in our list of the financing rounds, the most important of these being the Zürcher Kantonalbank (ZKB). Private investors also play an important role. Often they act with the help of very different organisations, such as CTI Invest or business angel clubs like Startangels, BioBAC, GoBeyond or investiere.ch.

The list of the 10 biggest investments shows a strong impact of "born globals", with start-ups Sportradar, ADC. Bravofly and Nivio in this category. These three companies have only their headquarters in Switzerland. In addition, two other companies on the top 10 list (Biocartis and HouseTrip) are international in the sense that a large number of their employees are based abroad. Almost all of them are in the later stage.

Methodology

The numbers are based on financing round reports by startupticker.ch, completed by other sources, e.g. CTI Invest, CTI Start-up and directly from the companies or Investors.Below, you will find the data of these financing rounds with links to the reports. Of course, this means that only investments that have been made public or were communicated in another way could be included; in reality, the number of investments and the invested sum are higher.

Not all companies made public how much capital they generated. For the statistical analysis confidential information were used plus estimates where necessary. The Investment phases are defined as follows:

Seed: Founders, 3F's, Foundations, average amount below CHF 1 Mio.

Early Stage: Round A, First Round, BA and VC's, average amount between 1-5 Mio.

Later Stage: Growth, Expansion, Second Round, after Round A, VC's, average amount over CHF 5 Mio.

As Industry Focus the following categories were differentiated:

ICT, Biotech, Medtech, Micro/Nano, Cleantech, Interdisciplinary
